### Position Summary:

The Laser Alignment Test Technician will be responsible for optical/laser assembly, Alignment, test and calibration, along with data collection and analysis. In addition, perform rework on assemblies and/or systems in response to failures and nonconformance.

### Duties and Responsibilities:

- Calibrate and Burn-in high power laser systems.
- Assemble, clean, Align and test electro-optical assemblies, and laser systems to meet performance specifications.
- Verify Electrical specification with oscilloscope and multimeters
- Troubleshoot and perform problem isolation on Laser system and sub-assembly components.
- Collect and evaluate test and build data to ensure process control and product quality based on specific procedures and processes.
- Interface with engineers on special tests and qualification testing of new products: This includes developing test methodology, establishing test parameters and drafting procedures.
- Develop and maintain data systems to record and report test results. Provide technical input and evaluation on process improvements.
- Analyze equipment performance and schedule maintenance and calibration as required. Utilize online databases to accurately transact material, and review drawings and bills of material.

- Perform failure analysis and determine root cause with minimal instructions
- Ability to complete task within specified timeline.
- Maintain compliance with FDA, GMP/QSR, Manufacturing process/Work Instructions and ISO 13485.
